

### Как выглядит задание

Вы услышите интервью. В заданиях 3—9 запишите в поле ответа цифру 1, 2 или 3, соответствующую выбранному Вами варианту ответа. Вы услышите запись дважды.

#### Сложности

- 1. Большой объём материала, который нужно держать в памяти
- 2. Некоторые варианты ответов похожи
- 3. Высокий уровень лексики и грамматики
- 4. Высокий темп речи
- 5. Большой объём звучащего текста
- 6. Правильный ответ перефразирован (лексика, грамматика, синонимы, антонимы)
- 7. 50 секунд, чтобы прочитать задание

### Алгоритм выполнения 1

- 1. Пауза 50 секунд перед первым прослушиванием
- 2. Прочитать все вопросы, отмечая ключевые слова
- 3. Прочитать варианты ответов
- 4. Определить тему интервью по вопросам
- 5. Прослушать аудиозапись, ответить на вопросы, где ответ очевиден
- 6. Пауза 15 секунд
- 7. Прослушать текст ещё раз, отметить остальные ответы

### Алгоритм выполнения 2

- Прочитать только вопросы, отмечая ключевые слова
- 2. НЕ ЧИТАТЬ варианты ответов
- 3. Определить тему интервью по вопросам
- 4. Прослушать аудиозапись, обращая внимание, где в тексте звучит ответ на вопрос
- 5. В перерыве между прослушиванием (15 секунд) прочитать варианты ответов
- 6. Прослушать аудиозапись второй раз, отметить правильные ответы

There was nobody acting in my family, but there didn't need to be. I just understood what I wanted to do at once.
